The Barbecue Hall of Fame aims to educate others about barbecue's history and traditions while also honoring individuals who have made an outstanding impact on the world of barbecue.

Induction into the Hall of Fame is barbecue's top honor. On May 22, the American Royal will announce the class of 2024, including four living Hall of Fame inductees from this year's finalists and three legacy inductees who have passed.
