

WORLD SERIES OF BARBECUE[®] TEAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION 101

TO HAVE A SPACE AT THE BBQ:

- In order to have a space, teams must turn in at least one protein during the Open contest on Sunday and purchase space on the Speedway grounds.
 Judging on Sunday: Proteins include Chicken, Pork Ribs, Pork Shoulder or Beef Brisket must turn in at least one of these.
- Space and activities within your team space at the barbecue is at the team's discretion/responsibility to plan, manage, clean, etc. within the scope of the event guidelines. Please refer to team packet for rules/guidelines.
- Space is yours to do with what you would like within our regulations.

Setup and teardown must be within the set time provided by the American Royal

- Setup: Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at 8:00am until Friday, November 1, 2024, at 12:00pm/noon. Cannot bring vehicles into the infield after 12:00pm on Friday.
- Teardown: After awards on Sunday, November 3, 2024, after 6:00pm and must be cleared out/clean by 10:30pm (Leave the space as it was on arrival)

ITEMS FOR YOUR SPACE:

- Space/Entry **ONLY** includes your team's footprint on the ground. Additional items can be purchased through the American Royal. These items will be provided to the team with specifics about each.
 - Electric (20 amp drops), Trash Boxes and Bags, Ice, Porta Potties and Handwashing stations, etc. (see the team packet and registration for the full list of items for purchase)
- Vendors/Partners
 - If you choose to have the following, team must use the approved vendors provided by the American Royal, but management & payment is handled by the team:
 - Tent and Rentals: Marquee Event Rentals
 - Additional Electric (generators): Foley
- All other vendors/partners and setup is at the choice of the team
 - \circ $\;$ Includes, but not limited to: Catering, Décor, etc.
 - All vendors must abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the American Royal. Teams that contract vendors are responsible for providing the rules and regulations and ensuring that the vendors abide by these.



ONLINE REGISTRATION

All participants must apply via the application link on the website and pay for their space in full to be considered a contestant/team. All applications are subject to review and acceptance by the American Royal. Decisions made by the American Royal are final and not appealable. Teams may edit their own accounts based on the deadlines listed in the "IMPORTANT DATES/DEADLINES" section on the next page of this packet. Requests past these deadlines will need to be emailed to the barbecue team at <u>bbq@americanroyal.com</u>.

REGISTRATION PAYMENT PROCESS & OPTIONS

- Full payment via Credit Card at the time of registration
- Full payment via Check to be mailed to the American Royal offices

For teams opting to pay via check: Finishing your team's online registration without payment does not complete your registration. Registration data will be held until payment is received. **Team space assignments and map placement will NOT be made until the check payment is received.** It is strongly recommended to send the check immediately after you register if you would like your space honored. Teams paying via check and requesting the same space/first right of refusal from 2023 must send their check to the American Royal association by **July 28, 2024**. Full check payment must be received by October 2, 2024, in order to participate in the contest.

ONLINE REGISTRATION TIPS – BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- If you participated in 2023 or years prior, pull your registration before beginning as a reminder of your purchases.
- Be prepared with your team information including Chief Cook's contact, Team Name, Space Size, etc.
- Visit our website before registering and review the New Team Information packet and Team Packet.
- Online registration can take anywhere from 20 45 minutes.
- Forget something? Need to change something? No problem make sure you make an account at the end of the registration and then you can log back in and make any needed adjustments.
- Put the deadlines/cut off dates in your calendar.
- There will be a \$100 late fee for teams who register after September 26, 2024 (new registrations only not edits).

Notes about the above chart: Elements included are items managed by the American Royal and Marquee Event Rental. Additional costs such as Catering, Décor, supplies for competition, etc. are at the team's discretion. The only requirement of the above elements is the team space cost – all other items are at the discretion of the team to purchase.

The cost above is based on the estimate of 7-10sq.ft per person. This allows for a small amount of equipment and supplies. Please ensure that you are basing your space size off of the items that will be in your space as well as plenty of space for your guests. Each space may have one vehicle in their allocated space as well. The American Royal is not responsible for inaccurate estimates of your team space needs.

YOUR TEAM HAS REGISTERED, NOW WHAT?

BEFORE THE WEEKEND:

- Read the team packet it is packed full of information and important dates/deadlines
- Read and understand parking and what to do with your vehicles prior to arrival and when you arrive.
- Read and understand the KCBS judging rules and practice your timing!
 - \circ $\;$ If possible, take a CBJ class. It really helps to understand how the judging occurs.
 - Also, if possible, go to another KCBS sanctioned competition prior. The judging will be the same but the Royal is much larger and more intense.
- Electric: be aware that the electrical plug you will get is like the one in your home. You may need an adapter. Check what you plan on plugging in prior.
- Check the weather about 4 days out. At that time consider that the days may be warm, but the early mornings and nights could get very cool be prepared for all types of weather.

PACKING AND PREPARING:

- When you begin packing for the weekend:
 - $\circ~$ First consider that you are going on a camping trip for 3-4 days pack for that!
 - o Secondly, consider all the items you need to compete
- Food: when purchasing food for the competition, don't forget about your own meals.
- Fill your camper with water before you arrive.
- Extension cords:
 - \circ $\;$ Bring extra and the longest ones you have
- Supplies:
 - \circ $\;$ Get plenty of trash bags and trash boxes. (We sell them too!)
 - Paper Towels get extra

COMPETITION NOTES:

- Don't forget about your garnish! It affects your turn in box and presentation
- Walk and time your walk from your space to turn in and back, you will need to know this when turning in
- Check the times of the cooks' meetings and set a reminder for those.
- Make extra you will want to pick the best to present to the judges



- Don't forget about lighting
- Have extra coolers for ice not just for food and beverage
- Tents will not be provided with space be sure to bring your own or order in advance.

THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND:

- Ice will be available to be purchased and picked up or delivered to your spot!
- Clean up
 - Keep your space clean throughout the weekend it will help your Sunday clean up and load out.
 - On Sunday after awards, you have a couple hours to clean up. Begin your clean up Sunday morning while cooking for the open meats competition.

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
