



Field Trip FAQ

- **When is the 2026 Field Trip?**
 - April 22nd, 23rd, and 24th.
 - Schools can select one or multiple of these days for their students to attend.
- **Where do I go to register my school or organization?**
 - Registration can be found on our website under the Education tab.
- **What is the fee to register a school or organization?**
 - Student and Teacher tickets are \$7.00.
 - All parent/chaperone tickets are **NOT** associated with the registration form and must be purchased separately through the American Royal website.
 - Parent/Chaperone tickets can be purchased on our website under the Youth Rodeo tab.
- **Can Homeschool Groups attend?**
 - Yes!
- **When does registration open?**
 - September 30, 2025
- **When does registration close?**
 - March 20, 2026, at midnight central time.
- **What if my school cannot be at the American Royal at 9:00 AM when programming begins?**
 - It is recommended that schools arrive by 10 AM at the latest to be able to participate in the Experiential Tours before heading into the arena to watch the Youth Rodeo.
- **How many chaperones should we bring?**
 - It is recommended that classrooms with 18+ students have 2 chaperones.



- **Will lunch be provided?**
 - No, students must bring their own food and drink.

- **Where will my students be eating lunch?**
 - Students will be seated in Hale Arena to eat their lunch. This is where the rodeo will take place and opening ceremonies will begin at noon. The performance may begin while students are still eating.

- **What are the Experiential Tours?**
 - The Experiential Tours are a series of agricultural stations from different agriculture organizations in Kansas and Missouri.
 - Stations will be set up for classrooms to rotate through and students to hear about different agricultural entities.
